Rules:

- 1. These spots are for seniors only.
- 2. <u>You MUST have a parking pass prior to painting their space.</u> For the parking pass, there is a link in the newsletter and you can pay via <u>myschoolbucks.com</u>. The pass may be picked up at the front desk once the application and payment are submitted.
- 3. You must have your design approved, sign an agreement, and pay the \$10.00 fee before you paint your spot.
- 4. You must check in on painting day prior to beginning your painting. Painting can not take place at any other time.
- 5. You must paint over your spot with black, latex, EXTERIOR, water-based paint by May 25, 2021. If you do not clean and paint over your spot by the end of the year, you will not be permitted to walk at graduation.
- 6. Your spot is only "yours" during school hours (Monday to Thursday 7:30-4:00) and can be used by other scholars and parents for school events, games, etc. outside school hours.
- 7. The Parking Space Painting day will be held on <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 15th</u>, <u>2021 at 7:00 am</u>. You must have it completed by 4:00 pm that same day. We will supply the chalk for drawing the design on asphalt and paint.
- 8. YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN PAINT AND SUPPLIES!
- 10. You must use latex, EXTERIOR, water-based paint.
- 11. You are not allowed to use oil-based paint, spray paint, reflective, textured, glitter, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- 12. You will be randomly assigned a spot and you must use that spot, no changing!
- 13. You must leave two inches between your design and the parking line. Use masking tape to make sure this happens.
- 14. No paint is allowed outside your parking spot and you must use a drop cloth tarp under all your painting supplies/ your paint can.
- 15. Do not step on other's spots or on their designs, be respectful please!
- 16. No glass containers are permitted!
- 17. If you do not abide by any of these rules, your parking spot will be taken away and you will be required to paint over it, otherwise you will not be allowed to walk at graduation!

What I need to bring:

- 1. Latex, EXTERIOR, water-based paint.
- 2. Brushes, rollers, and/or sponges to apply the paint (nothing else is permitted)
- 3. Masking tape to mark off two inch border from white lines
- 4. Stool or towel to sit on
- 5. Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
- 6. <u>Plastic</u> containers for water, paint and brushes. No glass containers permitted.
- 7. Sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, water, snacks, etc.

Painting Tips:

- It will take about 2-3 quarts of paint to cover the spot if you are using a solid color.
- Tape the edges of your spot with a 2 inch margin before painting.
- Do not paint on the white lines or parking lot curbs.
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot.
- Use chalk to draw out your sketch.
- Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper)
- Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images to save a lot of time.
- Bring extra plastic containers (no glass) for water and brushes.
- Bring a drop cloth or plastic sheeting to put under paint cans. **NO paint is permitted outside** your spot.
- Limit your paint palette as the quarts of paint are expensive or share colors with a friend.
- Your family may already have leftover exterior house paint at home that you can use.
- Open the paint can at home and check to see if it is still usable before the paint date.
