

- **ALL** sections of some classes may be Dual Enrollment optional, we do not offer non-dual enrollment sections for all classes

**Be sure to follow all steps. This includes uploading all required documents and signing the financial responsibility forms as well as taking the EdReady test!**

**Also be sure to write down your MEID and password. This will be needed for signing into your student account for the rest of the time you take Dual Enrollment classes or attend Rio Salado or any other Maricopa Community College.**

Some classes are year long and only register in the Fall, i.e. MAT 187

Some classes are semester long and register each semester, i.e. ENG 101 and ENG 102

## The Promise:

- ❑ CAC will provide tuition-free education; 4 consecutive semesters, no credit restrictions



## The Promise:

- ❑ Funds are applied after FAFSA is filed and any assistance (not student loans) are used
- ❑ Student must take 12 credits, complete 9 and maintain 2.5 cumulative gpa





## Requirements

- ❑ live in Pinal County & graduate from a Pinal County public or charter high school with a 2.75 or higher cumulative GPA and 20 hours of community service
