



Summer School Courses 2023

Heritage Academy in-person summer courses are only offered for junior high school students in grades 6th to 8th. High school students (grades 9-12) may take an online summer school course offered through Edgenuity or through another school of your choice. **Because of the varied quality of such courses, approval must be obtained from Heritage before registering for such courses if not using Edgenuity.** A proficiency test may be administered before credit is granted. 1. To strengthen elementary skills to prepare for junior high classes at Heritage Academy, and
2. To show the administration at Heritage Academy that the student is serious about doing the work assigned. Heritage Academy is a homework school. If a student shows that he or she will not complete assigned work in summer school, he or she will probably not be successful at Heritage Academy and may be required to repeat the grade next year.
