Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in History Classes 3.75 or above

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Requirements:

Do any two of the following:

- a. DAR Good Citizenship
- b. George and Stella Knight Essay Contest
- c. National Essay Contest
- d. Profile in Courage Project
- e. Project Citizen
- f. National History Day

Report to History Department Chair Ms. Allen by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Science



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Science Classes 3.75 or above

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Requirements:

- -During senior year, complete 10 hours of unpaid tutoring.
- -Read & discuss a book from the approved list with your distinction advisor. Write a 1000-word paper on the book.

Report to Science Department Chair Mrs. Hilsinger by May 1st of the year you graduate.



English



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in English Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

-Read at least 10 books from the Heritage Academy Classics list - including a Shakespeare play. (Not Read in Class)


-Set up time to discuss the books with any of the English Faculty.

-Submit a final list of all books you have read. You will have a final discussion with the English distinction advisor.

Report to English Department Chair Mrs. Andres by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Math



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Math Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

- -Take MAT187 Precalculus and/or MAT 220 Calculus
- -Read an approved Mathematics book from an approved list or create a short presentation on a Precalculus topic to share with a Math teacher.
- -Complete 10 hours of unpaid peer tutoring (must be reported to and recorded by a Heritage Math teacher).

The deadline to complete these requirements is May 1st of the year you graduate. Please ensure you've discussed this with Mrs. Steelman much earlier in your senior year.





Spanish

Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Spanish Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements: -Must complete three years of Spanish and complete two of the following


- -Historical: Write a 5-page double-spaced research paper using MLA style. Your paper should research one of the following individuals who have had a significant impact on the history of their respective Spanish-speaking nations.
- -Art: Prepare a 5-minute presentation in Spanish on some art form (painting/sculpture, music). You may choose to focus on a given artist or a movement.
- -Literature: Read 4 of the stories listed below in Spanish. Before reading, study some of the background behind the work, learn about the author, and then read the work/works listed. Discuss the work with your instructor.
- -Culture: Prepare a 5-minute classroom presentation in Spanish on a selected cultural topic. This topic must be approved by the teacher and you must work with him in preparing your presentation. Suggested topics may include celebrations, foods, independence, etc... Please consult with the teacher before beginning work on the presentation. The presentation must be in PowerPoint or Prezi format.

French





Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in French Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hours requirement for graduation to qualify.


Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements: -Must complete three years of French

Complete an in-depth 5-10 page research paper focusing on French-speaking people from a French-speaking country paying attention to how the language is used and why it is used there as well as the culture of the people. Submit to Mrs. Licon.

Report to French Teacher Mrs Licon. by May 1st of the year you graduate.





ASL

Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in ASL Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

Must complete three years of ASL

Complete an in-depth research report on a famous Deaf person. Should be between 5-10 pages. Must be turned in and reviewed by Ms. Turik.

Report to ASL Teacher Ms Turik by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Dance



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Dance Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

-4 Consecutive Years of Dance Level 2 and Up

- -90% attendance and must be present at all performances
- -Create a self-choreographed piece, meeting the guidelines provided, and have it showcased at one of the performances in your 4 years.
- Research Paper with topic approved by the instructor, 5-10 pg paper focused on a certain dance style, technique, or choreographer.

(If there are extenuating circumstances that you feel should be considered. You may present a written proposal to Ms. Ashley by April 1st of your Senior year.)

Report to the Dance Teacher Ms. Ashley by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Social Dance



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Social Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

- 6 semesters of Social Dance (4 if you are part of the 2024 graduating class)
- 5 outside class dance activities (at least 2 must be teaching activities)\
- Choreograph a piece to be performed during the showcase
- 4-page typed research paper (approved by Teacher)

Report to Social Dance Teacher Mrs. Price by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Drama



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Drama Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.


Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

-Students must earn a minimum of 60 points or roughly 600 hours in order to reach Honor Thespian rank in the International Thespian Society

Report to Drama Teacher Mrs. Vargas by May 1st of the year you graduate.





Film

Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Film Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

Create and submit a portfolio of work; Various stills, 3 screenplays, 3 films for review, upon approval.

- -Submit a film to one or more of the following:
 - The Arizona Short Film Festival.
 - The Arizona Student Film Festival.
 - Arizona International Student Film Festival.
 - Or any approved, comparable, festival.

Report to Film Teacher Mr. Hettinger by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Choir



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Choir Classes 3.75 or above Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements:

- -Be in a Choir for at least 4 semesters in High School
- -Audition to be in an "advanced ensemble"
- -Participate in an "Advanced ensemble" for at least 2 semesters.
- -Prepare and audition for the All Regional Honor Choir (or other approved audition)
- -Pass the Music Knowledge Final with a score of at least 90%
- -Prepare written reflection on experience in the choir (or similar/Consult with Mr. Bunker)

Report to Choir Teacher Mr. Bunker by May 1st of the year you graduate.



Band



Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Band Classes 3.75 or above

Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements: Be in Band Class for 4 semesters and do 2 of the following.

- -Can play C scale, and then Scales with up to 4 sharps and 4 flats.
- -Participate in additional events such as regional auditions or other events outside of Heritage as approved by the teacher.
- -Scholars can take private lessons for a full year for their primary instrument

Report to Band Teacher Mr. Hughes by May 1st of the year you graduate.





Art

Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Art Classes 3.75 or above Must have all service hour requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements: Take Art for 4 semesters.

-In his/her senior year, the scholar must submit a portfolio of their work containing a minimum of 10 pieces. Portfolios must demonstrate knowledge of techniques and media learned throughout the previous four years. Portfolios will be approved by the Art teacher

Scholars must have at least two pieces of artwork on display each year at the annual Heritage Academy Art Exhibit.

The Scholar must participate in a public community art showcase or vendor event and have artwork on display (Art teacher can help to facilitate this). This can be done at any point between freshman and senior year.

Report to Art Teacher Mr. Jimenez by May 1st of the year you graduate.





Orchestra

Distinction: excellence in a specific area that sets someone apart from others

GPA in Orchestra Classes Must have all service hour 3.75 or above requirements for graduation to qualify.

Overall GPA: 3.5 or above

Requirements: Be in Orchestra for 4 semesters. Complete two of the following:

- -Can play three-octave major scales (2-octave for double bass) up to 3 sharps and 3 flats.
- -Participate in additional events such as regional auditions or other significant events outside of Heritage as approved by the teacher
- -Scholars take private lessons for a full year in their primary instrument

Report to Orchestra Teacher Mr. Hamilton by May 1st of the year you graduate.
