We are so excited for the start of the 2025-2026 school year! School hours are 8:00 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Thursday. Our first day of classes will begin on **Wednesday, July 16th**.

# **CLASS SCHEDULES**

Your scholar's schedule will be available to view in PowerSchool on July 11<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM. You must use a computer to see the schedule. The PowerSchool app will not show their schedule until the first day of school. Directions on how to login on your computer are found below under "PowerSchool Logins".

# **SCHEDULE CHANGES**

A schedule change will only be considered for the following reasons:

- Medical necessity, as documented by a physician
- Class of 2026 Senior missing a required course
- Missing a course in your schedule (there's a blank spot in your schedule). Seniors can have blank spots if they are coming in late or leaving early.
- Incorrect class placement (i.e. placed in College Mathematics instead of General Math)

If you feel that your reason for requesting a schedule change conforms to one of the reasons listed above, please go ahead and complete this form:

## **SCHEDULE CHANGE REQUEST FORM**

During the first two weeks of school, your request will be evaluated and if it is determined that a schedule change is possible, your scholar will be called to the office during school to discuss options. You will receive an email if the requested schedule change is not possible.

## **POWERSCHOOL LOGINS**

## **HOW TO LOGIN TO POWERSCHOOL**

## **GOOGLE CLASSROOM**

All Heritage scholars have been assigned an email address to use to sign-in to Google Classroom. They will sign into their email on their first day of school while on campus and create a new password. Teachers will invite the scholars to their Google Classroom in the first few days of class.

### SCHOOL SUPPLIES

The following is a list of items recommended for each class. If you don't see one of your classes listed, your teacher will provide a list of items needed on the first day of class.

## ATTENDANCE

1. Call the school or use the Safe Arrival App before **10:00 am** the day of the absence.

## HOW TO REPORT AN ABSENCE THROUGH SAFE ARRIVAL APP

- 2. Leave a message or report the reason for the absence.
- 3. Check google classroom for work they missed in class.

Any scholar who misses ten percent (10%) or more of classes (usually five or more per semester) in a given subject, may not receive credit for that subject. Each teacher sets his/her own policy for work missed. Furthermore, many experiences and activities by their very nature cannot be duplicated or "made up."

## TARDY POLICY

Scholars are allowed to be dropped off starting at 7:30 am and are considered tardy if they are not in their seat by 8:00 am. If a scholar is tardy more than 3 times/semester they will be pulled into a "lunch sweep," (similar to a detention) during their lunch period, and for every tardy after. A meeting with Parents is held on the scholar's 5th tardy, and a scholar will be suspended on the 6th tardy.

# DRIVELINE

We have double traffic lines around our building. Please always follow directions of staff members. Once you have reached the drop-off zone, pull all the way up to the crosswalk (or as far as you can) before dropping off.

If you are in the **LEFT** lane, scholars must exit to the sidewalk out of the **LEFT** side of your vehicle. If you are in the **RIGHT** lane, scholars must exit out of the **RIGHT** side of the vehicle and walk up to the crosswalk to cross traffic. Please leave the center lane open for vehicles to exit.

After school, **the driveline will not open until 3:20 PM**. Vehicles are not allowed to line up on the streets until 3:15 PM. The Maricopa Police Department will be issuing citations for anyone in violation. **If you do arrive early, please use the gravel lot on the West side of Our Lady of Grace Parish as a "Cell Phone Lot." At 3:20 PM you may enter the driveline.** Please queue up in both lanes around the building to maximize vehicle capacity.

## PARKING PERMITS

Due to the construction, there will be a limited number of scholar parking permits available for **Seniors Only**. The cost will be \$75 (which includes the painting fee) and are available on a first come, first served basis. A separate email will be sent out to Seniors with requirements and purchasing information on July 7<sup>th</sup>.

All other scholar drivers are welcome to park in the "Cell Phone Lot" (free of charge). Parking is not allowed on the neighborhood streets. Violators will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

## FORGOTTEN "OOPS" ITEMS

If your scholar forgets items for school, we ask that you fill out the "OOPS" form in the front office. Your scholar will be notified that the item is at the front office. As a reminder, **no outside food (fast food or delivery) is allowed.** 

### COURSE PRE-ASSESSMENTS

Each teacher will be administering a pre-assessment in every class. This information will help us determine if we have them placed correctly.

### LUNCH INFO

Scholars are able to pack and bring a lunch from home, or lunches are available for purchase at <u>myhotlunchbox.com</u>. You will need to create an account if you haven't already. If you do have an account, please visit the profile section to update your scholar's grade level to the correct one. The calendar should be open to orders a week before school starts. Vendors are subject to change at the start of each semester. **No outside food (fast food or delivery) is allowed.** The school does not provide a lunch if your scholar forgets.
